Founders Day Scholarship

Each year the Alumni Association acknowledges outstanding alumni at its traditional Founders Day celebration during the month of February. At that time, the Alumni Association also presents a University of Utah student with a one-year full tuition scholarship The scholarship is awarded to a student who has 1) overcome difficult life circumstances or challenges and 2) has given service to the University and the community.*

Achievement Scholarships

In addition to the Founders Day Scholars, the Association awards at least six Achievement Scholarships of \$3,000 each to students selected from among the Founders Day Scholarship pool of applicants. Achievement scholars are recognized at the Spring Awards Banquet on April 21, 2010.

**Full tuition will be based on undergraduate resident tuition schedule for the 2010-2011 academic year.*

Minimum Eligibility Requirements. Applicant must:

- Be a current student at the University of Utah
- Have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0
- Be able to attend the Founders Day Dinner on **February 24, 2010**, at Little America Hotel (Founders Day Scholar only)
- Submit an official U of U transcript, and include:
 1. a one-page sealed letter of recommendation (from an employer, teacher/professor, or community service professional)
 2. a two-page, single-sided, double-spaced essay explaining the challenges or difficult circumstances you have overcome, and the inspirations or life experiences that have had an impact on you. (Please insert your name at the top of each page of submitted material.)

Academic performance, other scholarships, and community service may be considered in the selection process.
